ERRP Extends March 30, 2012 Deadline To Submit Error-Free Claim List To April 27, 2012

The Early Retiree Reinsurance Program (ERRP) has extended the deadline for Plan Sponsors to submit an error-free Claim List that passes the automated edits and an associated reimbursement request. Plan Sponsors that have received an ERRP reimbursement for any given plan year now have until April 27, 2012 (an extension from March 30, 2012) to submit the required Claim List and associated reimbursement request for that plan year.

Given the extension was not announced until March 30, 2012, the original deadline, the announcement was somewhat less than timely. The announcement is posted online at: <http://www.errp.gov/index.shtml>.

The announcement **warned** that Plan Sponsors who have received an ERRP reimbursement but who have not submitted an error-free Claim List and a corresponding reimbursement request by April 27, 2012, will no longer be able to submit requests for reimbursements after such date, and CMS will initiate procedures for recoupment of the funds paid to the Plan Sponsors for such plan years. In the case of such collection, any funds returned to the program will be used to pay outstanding reimbursement requests in the order in which they were received.
